QUESTEK TRANSIT TECHNOLOGIES GAINS FOOTPRINT IN EASTERN CAPE

Questek Transit Technologies (QTT), leaders in integrated electronic ticketing systems for the public transport industry, has been awarded two contracts in the Eastern Cape, which will firmly establish their presence in this region.

The first contract to the value of approximately R2 million was awarded by Africa Best 350 (AB350) and includes the installation of QTT's Wayfarer ticketing system into 71 buses.

AB350 is a consortium of individual, small bus operators situated in the Eastern Cape, that have established a 100 percent empowered company with a focus on purchasing new buses to service the former Transkei region.

Additionally, Buffalo City Municipality has awarded QTT the tender to install their electronic ticketing system into 15 buses.

QTT has a long-standing relationship with the Eastern Cape transport industry. Algoa Bus Company and Mayibuye Transport have operating on the Wayfarer system for the past years.

“Electronic ticketing solutions give bus operators comprehensive management information in order to streamline their business, including passenger information and route monitoring. The system is based on contactless smart card ticketing, which helps to manage revenue and increase operational efficiencies,” says Ronald Salis of QTT.
